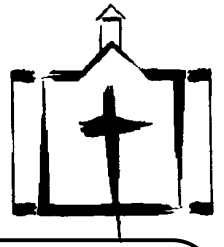

**Places of Welcome**

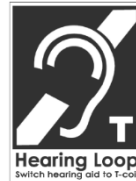
