## REGULATIONS FOR THE GARDEN OF REMEMBRANCE, 2019

The interment of cremated remains in the area of the Church's grounds dedicated as a Garden of Remembrance is available to all residents of the district of Bilbrook, members of Holy Cross Church and regular worshippers.

All graves shall be for the interment of the cremated remains of two family members.

The remains are interred by being poured directly into the ground.

There is the provision of a dedicated memorial stone, on which names may be included, and the grave area shall remain unmarked.

There is an additional fee for the engraving of the stone, as well as a per-letter cost – arrangements are to be made with the stonemason by the family, please see attached form for details.

There will be vases for a limited number of flowers adjacent to the memorial stone. No flowers or any other article are to be left on the grave area. For birthdays, anniversaries etc., families and friends are encouraged to sponsor flowers for the decoration of the church, but not during the seasons of Lent and Advent.

The Garden of Remembrance is usually open for visitors.

The fees for the interment of ashes are those laid down by the Church of England, which for 2019 are **£162**, of which £121 goes to the church and £41 to the Diocese of Lichfield.

There is also a cost for the preparation of the grave (currently **£60**, £80 on Sundays).

The fee for the addition of a name to the memorial is **£27** (£14 to Holy Cross church and £13 to the Diocese), plus the cost of engraving.

The total fee is then **£249**. Please make cheques payable to **'Tettenhall PCC'**.
